

2023 Highlights

SERVING THE UNDERSERVED

In 2023, CompleteCare experienced growth in serving various special populations. The agricultural and seasonal worker populations saw a 7% increase, while homeless patients increased by 10%. The number of veteran health center patients rose by 23%, public housing patients increased by 15%, and those seeking services in our school-based health centers surged by 28%. Additionally, our total patient count rose by 3%, and total visits increased by 6%.

ACCESSIBLE HEALTH CARE SERVICES

CCHN remains committed to enhancing accessibility to healthcare services. In 2023, CompleteCare introduced the Medical Mobile unit to our service area. This cutting-edge medical unit enables CCHN staff to reach underserved populations where they reside and work. Moreover, our outreach team utilizes the vehicle to promote services across our service area and provide healthcare services at community events, schools, churches, and other venues.

Ensuring our health centers maintain the highest standards of quality and aesthetics for our patients is a continual focus at CCHN. This year, we commenced the process of replacing two existing facilities with new and improved locations. CompleteCare Women's Medical Professionals in Bridgeton will relocate to Pearl Street, while CompleteCare Dental Professionals in Bridgeton will transition to a newly remodeled and updated center across the street.

These initiatives align with our commitment to providing accessible and high-quality healthcare services to all individuals in our communities.

BRIDGING THE HEALTH CARE SHORTAGE

Cumberland County, often regarded as New Jersey's poorest and least healthy county, is poised for positive change. Thanks to a substantial grant exceeding \$2.5 million awarded to the Rutgers School of Nursing– Camden (RSNC) by the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA), enhanced training opportunities will be available for Nurse Practitioners (NPs). These highly skilled NPs will utilize their expertise to serve the residents of Cumberland County.

Administered over a four-year period by RSNC, the HRSA grant will facilitate training for NP residents. These residents will fulfill their clinical requirements at primary care sites managed by CompleteCare Health Network. This initiative holds promise for improving healthcare access and outcomes in Cumberland County, marking a significant step towards addressing its longstanding health disparities.

IMPROVED TECHNOLOGY

2023 introduced additional technology to our operations. We brought forth Sage, a platform that allows us to assist patients with obtaining insurance through an online portal. We also rolled out Accushelf, a vaccine administration and inventory program.



LOOKING AHEAD: 2024 & BEYOND

OPENING THREE NEW FACILITIES

Ensuring top-notch quality and visual allure in our health centers remains a priority at CCHN. This year, we're set to upgrade two existing facilities with modernized replacements. CompleteCare Women's Medical Professionals in Bridgeton will relocate to Pearl Street, while CompleteCare Dental Professionals in Bridgeton will shift to a newly renovated center just across the street. Additionally, we're excited to announce the upcoming inauguration of our inaugural Men's Health Center in Williamstown, NJ. Stay tuned for exciting developments in Cape May County as we embark on a new construction project in 2024.



OPERATIONS

Operations for all clinical service lines will continue to leverage technology and training in 2024. We are continuing to automate and build upon the technological structure foundations of 2023. We are using lessons learned with 2023 launches to refine processes and generate better outcomes. Our teams continue to focus on standardization so that employee and patient experience are the same at all locations and throughout all departments. We will continue building on our training to ensure each team member is equipped with the skills and knowledge necessary to carry out our mission in every visit and interaction.

HRSA OPERATIONAL SITE VISIT

In 2024, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) will conduct its Operational Site Visit (OSV). This visit serves to assess and confirm CCHN's adherence to the statutory and regulatory requirements of our program. We plan to successfully demonstrate full compliance during this evaluation.
