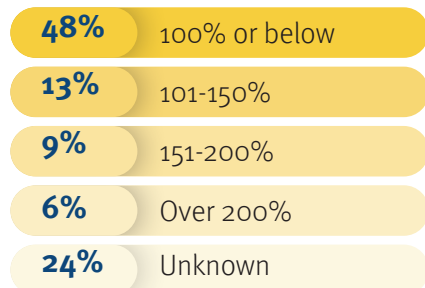

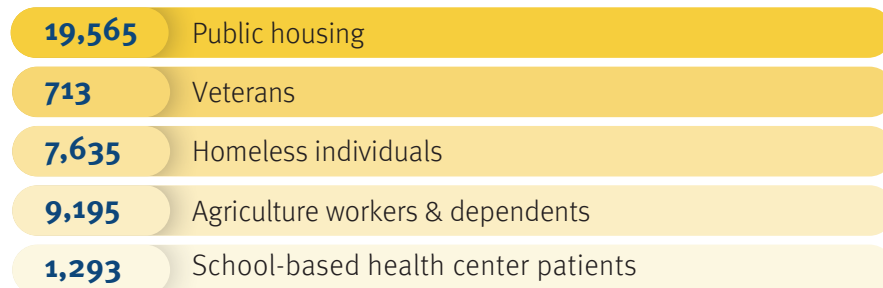

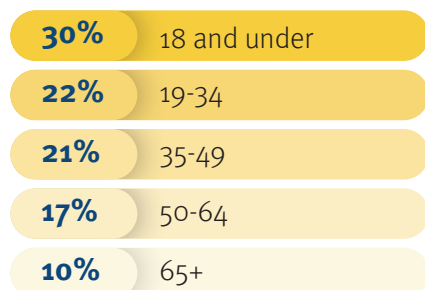
BY INCOME



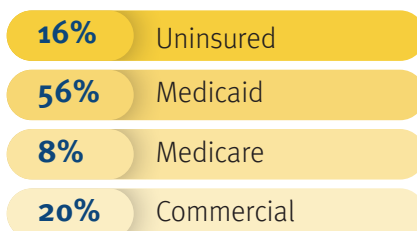
BY SPECIAL POPULATION



BY AGE

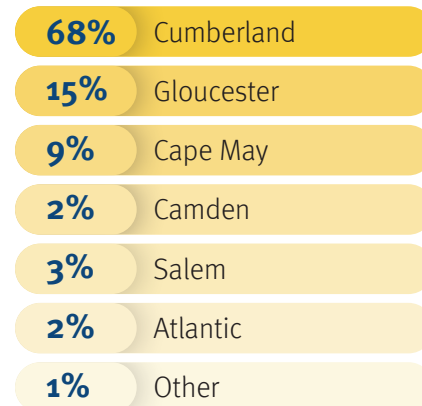


BY COVERAGE

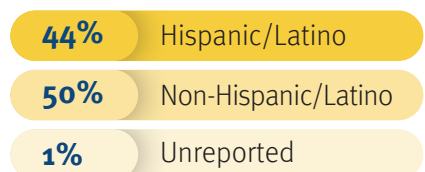

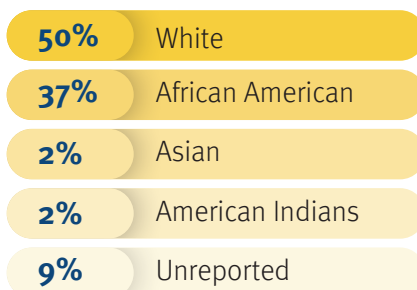
